<b>A</b>	PTP STUDENTS*	Enrolled on the Practitioner Training Programme of Modernising Scientific Careers or Year 4 BSC (Hons) Clinical Physiology Students. Proof of ongoing enrolment at the HEI may be required. PTP students from either respiratory or cardiology will be eligible to join.	FREE
<b>B</b>	STP STUDENTS*	Enrolled on the Specialist Training Programme of Modernising Scientific Careers. Proof of ongoing enrolment at the HEI may be required	£25
<b>C</b>	ASSISTANT PRACTITIONERS (with voting rights)	Employed in Respiratory Physiology or an allied discipline in Respiratory Medicine in a position that is below accredited status.	£28
<b>D</b>	ASSOCIATE MEMBER (with voting rights)	Employed in Respiratory Physiology or an allied discipline in Respiratory Medicine and be able to demonstrate relevant experience in Respiratory Physiology and Technology.	£42
<b>E</b>	ACCREDITED MEMBER (with voting rights)	An associate member who is currently accepted onto one of the voluntary registers below: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• RCCP</li> <li>• HCPC</li> <li>• AHCS register</li> </ul>	£42
<b>F</b>	ALLIED MEMBER (WITHOUT RECIPROCAL AGREEMENT)	Allied Profession member is anyone with an interest in Respiratory Physiology, working in a clinical environment that does not fulfil the criteria as specified in tariffs D and E	£42
<b>G</b>	ALLIED MEMBER (WITH RECIPROCAL AGREEMENT)	A concessionary tariff is available to members of affiliated professional bodies having a reciprocal agreement with ARTP	£32
<b>H</b>	CORPORATE MEMBER	Open to representatives of companies involved in the fields of respiratory technology, physiology and pharmacology membership is subject to approval by the Executive Committee	£275
<b>I</b>	CORPORATE MEMBER	Persons working in a clinical capacity are normally eligible for Assistant, Associate or Accredited membership. This category is open to persons not working in a clinical capacity that wish to hold a personal membership when their company is already a Corporate member	£42
<b>J</b>	OVERSEAS* MEMBER	Employed in Respiratory Physiology, or an allied discipline, or who has an interest in Respiratory Physiology. Other membership benefits are unaffected	£47
